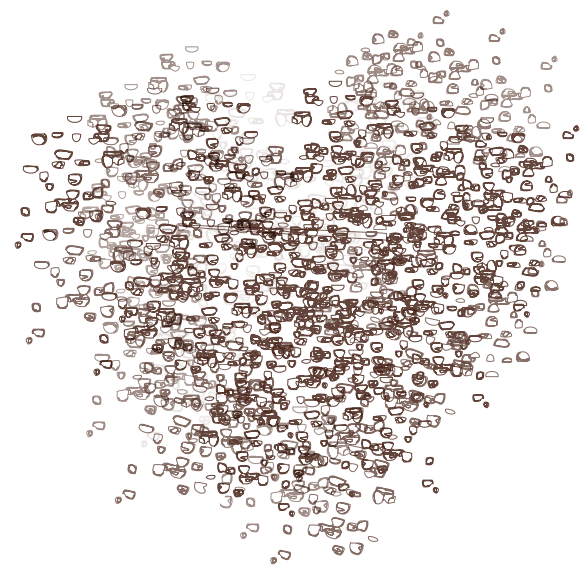


The Edge of Things
